Scale pilots

Remember the Aerominati Rule 11: 'If the canopy is transparent there must be a pilot.'

However haven't we all seen models with pilots that are ridiculously small. From the 4Max web site these are sizes needed for various scale of model. This is for the type of pilot where you get the upper part of the body from the waist up.

	Height (mm)	Width (mm)
1:10	70	70
1:9	80 – 85	75 - 80
1:8	85 – 90	80
1:7	105	95
1:6	120 – 130	115
1:5	145	140

Obviously for larger or smaller models the above can be scaled up or down. The odd thing is that if you take the 1:10 size and multiply it by 10, then multiply by 2, you get 1400 mm which is a lot short of an average height. Presumably these pilots are not from the waist up. For model pilots with more of their bodies missing I have included the widths.
